COURSE REGISTRATION

- Students must satisfy all course prerequisite requirements before registration can be processed.
- Students under the age of 16 are not eligible to enroll in ARTS 1110, ARTS 1120, ARTS 2010, CRIM (all courses), ENGL 2470, PHOT 1105, PSYC 1010, PSYC 1110, PSYC 1120, PSYC 2150, PSYC 2350, SOCI 2150, or VACA 2250.
- Provide course information for the term in which you plan to enroll by searching classes online or by scanning the QR code.



24/FA = Fall Quarter, September 3 – November 18, 2024. Registration opens May 9, 2024. 24/WI = Winter Quarter, December 2, 2024 – February 26, 2025. Registration opens September 25, 2024. 24/SP = Spring Quarter, March 7 – May 22, 2025. Registration opens January 16, 2025. 25/SS = Summer Quarter, June 5 – August 15, 2025. Registration opens March 26, 2025.
