

30104 Board's Advisory Groups

The Board of Governors may appoint advisory groups with broad, diverse representation to study problems and recommend solutions, provide information or perform other tasks as directed by the Board.

The Board's advisory groups shall serve in an advisory capacity and have neither administrative nor policy making authority.

Each appointee shall be notified of their term of service in the group and the specific task(s) the group is to perform. The group shall be instructed regarding its relationship with the Board and with College staff.

The Board shall have the sole authority to dissolve any of its advisory groups at any time.
