### **Application period open for Board of Governors Graduating Senior Scholarship**

OMAHA, Neb.—Metropolitan Community College's Board of Governors Graduating Senior Scholarship application window is open. This prestigious MCC award covers tuition charges for two years (eight consecutive quarters) for up to 18 credits per quarter.

The College will be accepting applications through March 1, 2014. Applicants must reside in Dodge, Douglas, Sarpy or Washington counties and must be graduating from a high school or home school in those counties. To be eligible, students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale, 3.43 on a 5.0 scale or be in the top 25 percent of their graduating class.

The scholarship is valid at any MCC location or online.
