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Program immerses high school educators in business world

OMAHA, Neb. — Metropolitan Community College invites high school teachers, counselors and administrators to apply for the 2014 MCC Summer Educator Internship program. The program immerses educators in the world of work outside the classroom, helping them to gain a deeper understanding of specific career fields and take that knowledge back to the classroom.

Educators selected for the program will participate in a 40-hour work experience at a local business. Participants will record skills observed on the job and develop curriculum recommendations, timelines for possible implementation and lesson plans for after the internship. Educators will build their skills and knowledge in a selected focus area. The Greater Omaha Chamber of Commerce will coordinate internships with participating educators and companies.

The program focuses on building skills and awareness of occupations in the following areas:

- Software developers and application developers
- Computer programmers
- Computer systems management
- Securities, commodities and financial service sales agents
- Engineers
- Sales representatives in wholesale and manufacturing
- Technical and scientific product developers
- Financial analysts
