MCC offers half-price tuition to high school graduates

OMAHA, Neb. — Metropolitan Community College is offering high school students who will graduate this spring the opportunity to take college courses at half-price tuition this summer.

Nebraska resident high school students qualify for half-price tuition through MCC's CollegeNOW! program, which encourages high school students to get a jumpstart on their college education. The discounted tuition extends through the quarter after the student's high school graduation.

MCC's standard tuition is \$53 per credit hour. With the discount, high school students may take courses for \$26.50 per credit hour. The discount applies to classes at any MCC location as well as online. Credits may be transferred to area colleges and universities.
