Visual Arts Student Exhibition to showcase the best of student work

OMAHA, Neb. — The 14th annual Visual Arts Student Exhibition opens April 24 at the Elkhorn Valley Campus Gallery of Art and Design, 204th Street and West Dodge Road. The juried exhibition features a selection of top work from MCC's Art, Design Interactivity and Media Arts, Photography and Video/Audio Communication Arts programs.

A record 241 pieces were submitted for the show, and about 65 of the entered pieces were selected for exhibition. Students compete for \$2,500 in scholarships, and the work in the show is for sale.

An opening reception and awards presentation will be Thursday, April 24, 5–7 p.m. in the Gallery of Art and Design.

The exhibit runs April 24–May 17. Gallery hours are Monday–Thursday, 9 a.m.–8 p.m., and Friday, 9–5 p.m.

The gallery is free and open to the public.
