### **Omaha Stamp Show to offer fun, history to visitors**

OMAHA, Neb. — The Omaha Stamp Show will be held at Metropolitan Community College Saturday, Sept. 6, 10 a.m.–5 p.m., and Sunday, Sept. 7, 10 a.m.–4 p.m. in the Industrial Training Center at the South Omaha Campus, 27<sup>th</sup> and Q streets.

The two day event will feature over 100 frames on display, an opening ceremony centered on the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of World War I as well as a kid's room where attendees can receive free stamps and other information regarding stamp collecting. The U.S. Post Office will also be on-hand to sell stamps and covers including 'Uncle Sam', 'Pershing Victory' and 'We Want You'.

Nationally sanctioned, the Omaha Stamp Show is part of the Philatelic Society World Series of Philately, a competitive series where exhibitors are judged and presented awards for their displays.
