STATISTA: FIND INDUSTRY & MARKET INFORMATION

To access **Statista** go to the MCC library website, click on the **Databases** tab (beneath the picture), then use the **Databases by Title** menu to select **Statista**.

Part 1: Default search box

1. Type the name of the industry, product, or service you are researching in the search box and click on **Search**.



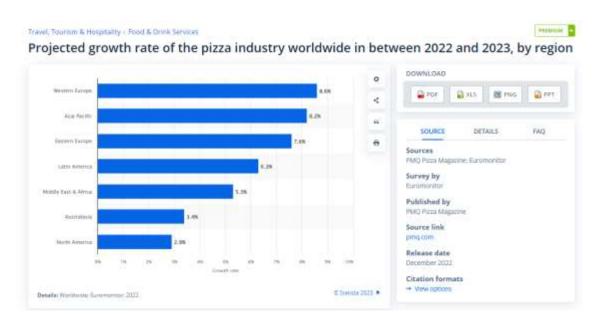
2. The next screen displays a list of records. Each record is labeled with the record type (topic, report, statistic, etc.).



3. **Statistic**: Clicking on a record labeled **Statistic** icon opens a chart, graph, table, etc. containing statistical data.

The record also includes information about the original **source** the data was provided by.

You can download the data in a number of formats: as a graphic, Excel spreadsheet, PowerPoint slide, or a PDF document.

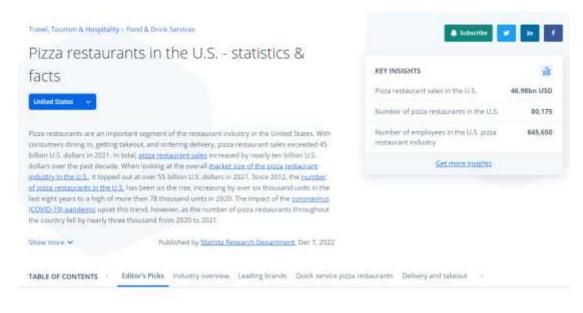


4. **Report**: Clicking on a record labeled **Report** opens a record with a link to a study or report. The record also includes report details such as the **release date**, **total number of pages**, and **Table of Contents**.

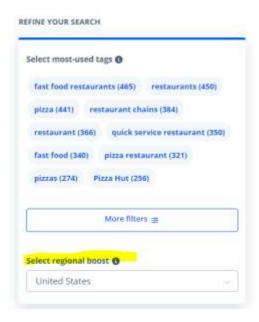
Click on **PowerPoint** or **PDF** to open the report.



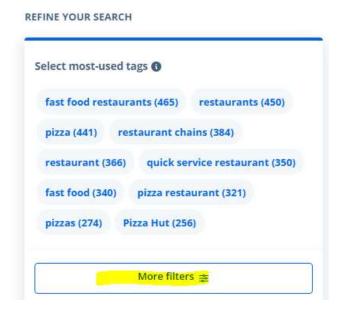
5. **Topic**: A record labeled **Topic** provides an overview with links to relevant statistics, reports, and related topics.



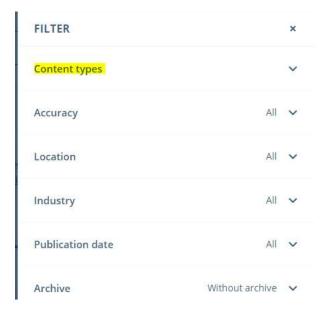
- 6. **Refine your search**: Use the **Refine your search options** on the results page to focus your search results.
 - a. For example, changing **Select regional boost** to **United States** limits your results to records relevant to the United States.

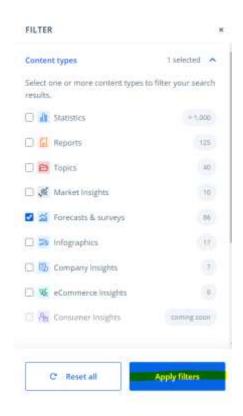


b. Click More filters to view other options.



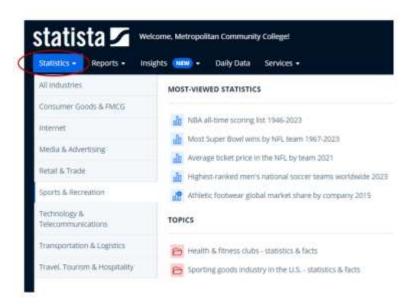
For example, selecting **Content types** lets you limit your results by record type.





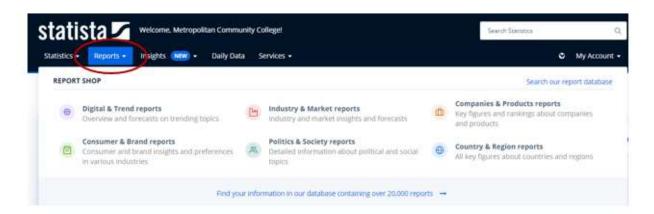
Part 2: Browse by Industry

Part 3: Reports

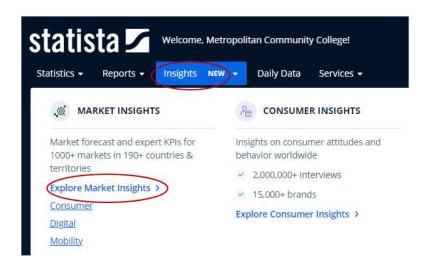
In addition to using the default search box, you can also access detailed reports by clicking the **Reports** link at the top. Then select from the list of categories.



Part 4: Market Insights

Click the **Insights** link to access insights, or in-depth analyses in selected sectors.

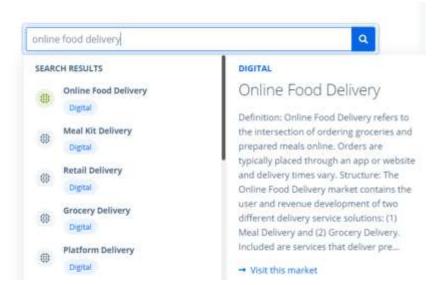
NOTE: The Library's subscription does not include full access to **Consumer Insights** or **eCommerce Insights**.
