Access Research Databases from home

Metropolitan Community College's libraries subscribe to 30+ databases containing full-text articles from thousands of magazines, newspapers, academic journals, and encyclopedias. These databases cover a wide range of topics: business, careers, computer science, criminal justice, current events, education, health and medicine, horticulture, management, psychology, science, social issues, sociology, vocational/technical trades, and more.

To access research databases from home, you must be a <u>currently enrolled</u> MCC student, faculty, or staff member and you must know your <u>MCC username</u> and <u>password</u>.

- 1. Go to the Library's webpage: www.mccneb.edu/library
- 2. Click on the **Databases** box
- 3. Use the **Title** menu to select a database
- 4. Enter your **username** and **password**:
 - Enter the same username/password you use to access MyWay, Blackboard, student e-mail, or log on to a MCC computer.

- 5. Click **Login**
