Dear F-1 Student,

Metropolitan Community College (MCC) is continuing its partnership with Academic Health Plans (AHP) and National Guardian Life (NGL) to provide you with health insurance for the 2019-2020 academic year. There are no changes in coverage. We expect to receive the benefits summary and the master policy in the next couple of months. Once they are available, International Student Services (ISS) will post them on the ISS website.

1. The annual deductible will not increase. It will remain at \$250 for in network providers and \$500 for out of network providers.
2. Prescriptions through AHP-NGL will not be subject to the deductible. You will only need to pay the copay (out of pocket).
3. If you will be continuing under the AHP-NGL policy, you may purchase insurance for dependents for the 2019-2020 policy year.

You will need to pay the premium in full according to the chart below before registering for classes. No exceptions will be made for partial payment options. If you do not make the full payment, you will not be allowed to register for classes at MCC which may result in your SEVIS record being terminated.

IMPORTANT: Students who enroll in Fall 2019 classes before the insurance hold has been applied to their account will need to pay the Fall and Winter 2019 insurance premium before Fall 2019 classes begin or risk the possibility of being dis-enrolled from those classes.
